GRAPHIC IMAGING SERVICES BRINGS NORTHERN AIRPORT INTO THE DIGITAL ARCHIVING AGE

Graphic Imaging Services, Inc., a Nevada based scanning and archiving company has created and completed a customized system for the Reno/Tahoe International Airport. Graphic Imaging (GISI) arrived at the airport where they performed on-site scanning of all large format drawings of the Airport and its facilities. These drawings, some very old, are now stored in a rapid retrieval and document management database. This database storage system not only protects drawings from the risk of loss or damage, but also allows airport authorities a far superior process when dealing with large future projects.

Why is scanning and archiving documents, the on-line systems of the future? Storage is the number one driver. In some larger companies, literally tons of paper and documents take up precious building space. On an average, it costs approximately \$2,150 per year to maintain a single five drawer filing cabinet, where between one and five percent of the documents are misfiled or even lost.

This system of the future gives business a 30% reduction in paperwork alone and adds two weeks a year to personnel time typically lost to searching for hard copy paperwork.
